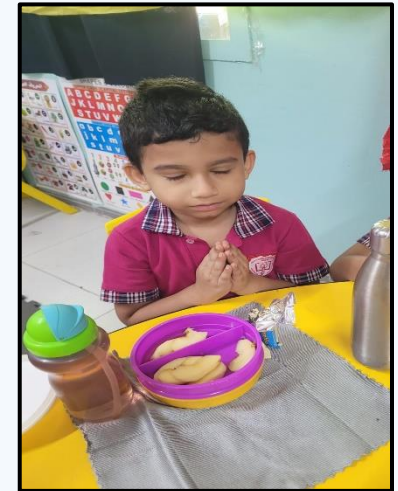
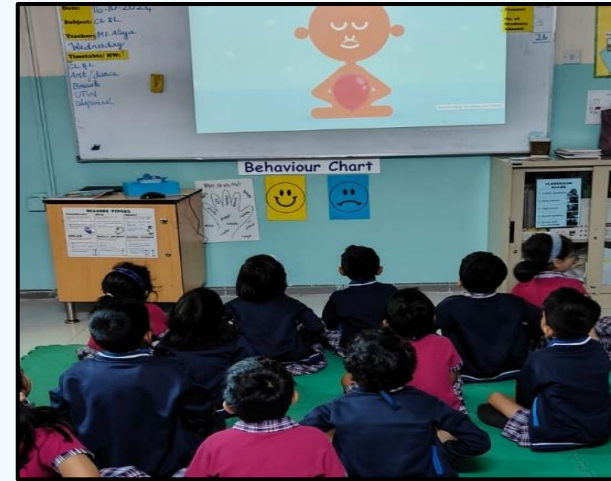
Our Responsibilities

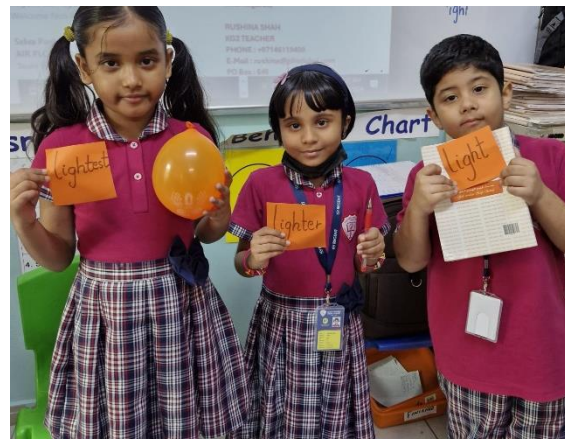
Literacy and Communication skills

Tips for Parents

Literacy: Encourage your child to focus on reading and writing simple sentences, regularly practice sight words, complete Reading Eggs assignments with planned screen time, and support them in their daily home learning activities.

Math: Encourage your ward to practice reading and writing numbers 1-30, identifying numbers before, after, and between, and work on addition and subtraction up to 20. Review 3D shapes and explore Mathseeds activities.

UTW: Explore nature with your child and discuss weather, seasonal changes, animals, plants, and more. Encourage them to practice writing simple phrases and sentences on these topics.

We kindly request parents to spend at least 30 minutes daily with your ward, discussing their school experiences, daily learning, and activities. Thank You.
