

ÉVARISTE GALOIS

The Teen Who Changed Mathematics Forever

Évariste Galois was a young French mathematician whose short but impactful life made a lasting mark on mathematics. Born in 1811, Galois displayed early talent and a passion for abstract math, tackling complex problems by the age of 16. He challenged traditional ideas and created what we now call Group Theory, a basis of modern algebra used today in cryptography, quantum physics, and computer science. Despite his brilliance, Galois faced constant rejection; his ideas were often ignored or misunderstood by older mathematicians.

Along with his academic challenges, he was heavily involved in the political turmoil of France and was arrested several times. At just 20 years old, he died in a mysterious duel.

The night before his death, knowing he was in danger, he stayed up writing down his mathematical discoveries, saying, “I have no time. I am dying. A pity.” Though he died young and unrecognized, his work was published after his death and transformed mathematics forever. Galois’ story serves as a strong reminder that true brilliance can shine even in hardship, and that age, rejection, and failure cannot stop a determined mind from making history.



A spark I somehow understand.


You're scrolling, thinking, learning, lost—

kind.


I love the noise, the mess, the flair,
